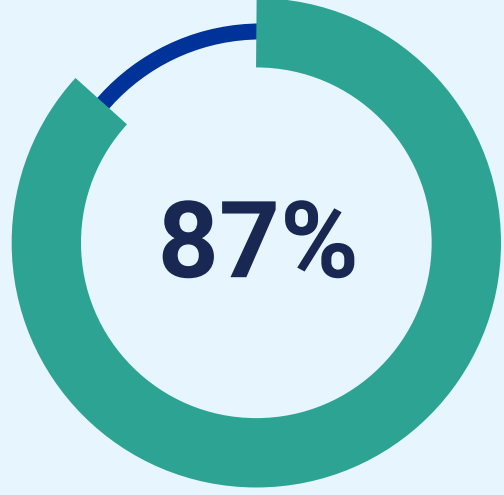


The Economic Downturn's Effect on IT Workloads

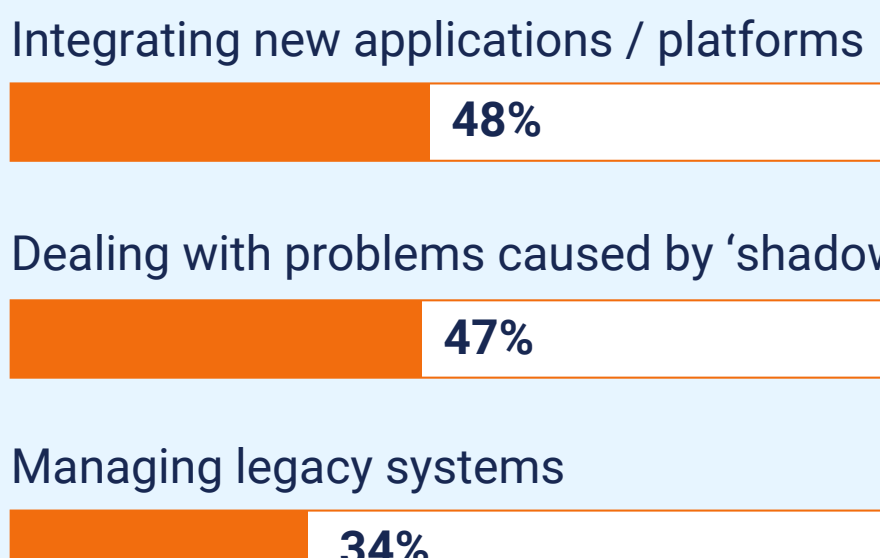


The IT Team's Workload Is on the Rise

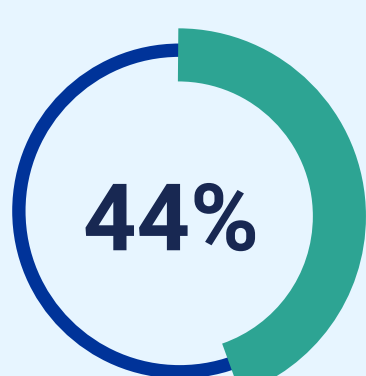


87% of respondents said their workload increased in the past six months

Hire or Fire?

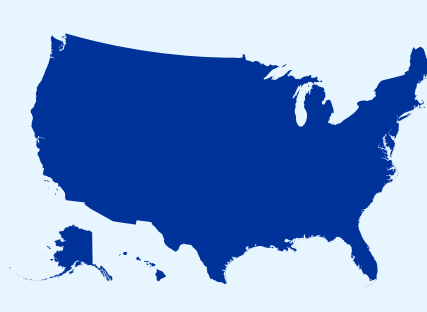


Just under half of all respondents are planning to freeze or reduce/have already reduced their IT headcount as a result of economic downturn and fears of recession, with some stark transatlantic differences:



Just over one quarter (29%) of Brits surveyed said they are hiring or plan to hire new people.

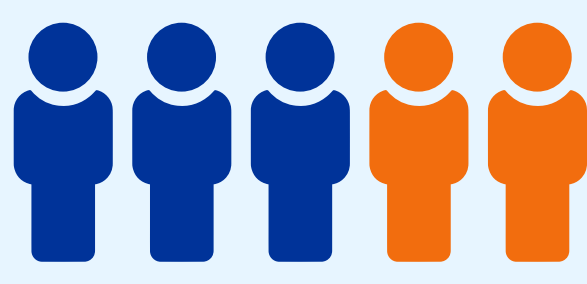

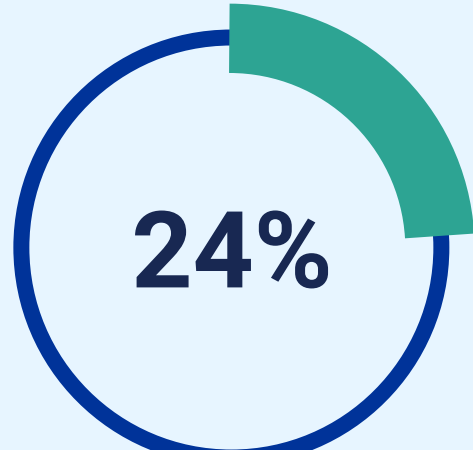
In sharp contrast, in the US, over two thirds (69%) are bullish; saying they are either hiring or plan to hire new people.

Shrinking IT Budgets



Three in five respondents (59%) said they either plan to, or have already decreased their IT budget as a result of the recent economic downturn and fears of a recession.



But nearly a quarter (24%) said they planned to increase their budget; suggesting a small minority are prioritizing IT investment despite—or perhaps because of—the economic climate.

Impacted Delivery

Just under half (45%) of respondents said that reduced or limited resources would mean their IT department will have to delay or cancel critical work;
